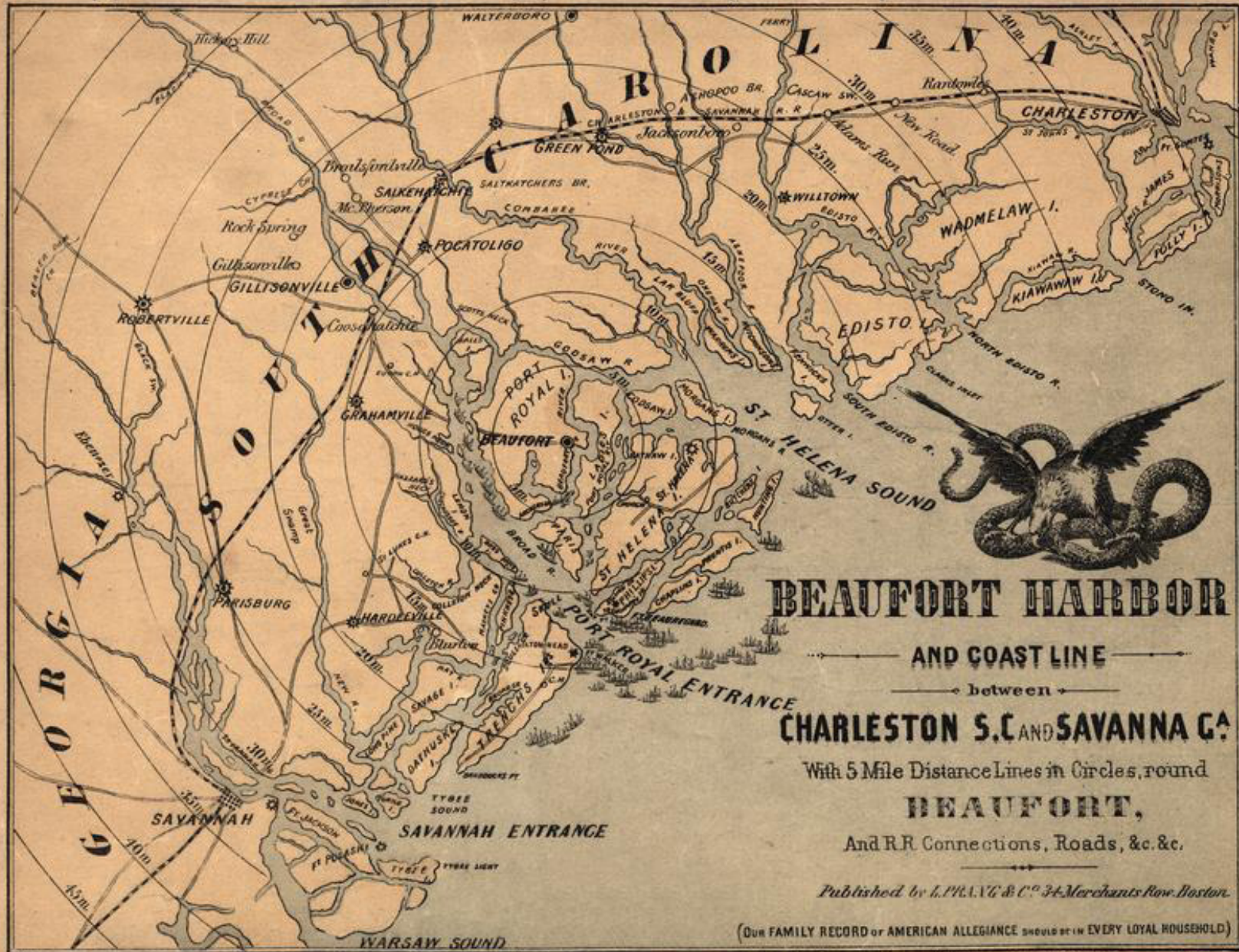


THE NAVAL FORCE IN THE GREAT EXPEDITION.
